Summary of Standard administration times Vs. Floating clock administration times.

Q 6 h — follows hospital's standard administration times.

Q 6 hr — follows a floating clock based off of when the provider placed the medication order.

Only use the "hr" time frame if clinically relevant for vancomycin, gentamicin, lovenox and heparin SQ.

Note: q day for meds means 0900 every day.
