

Admitting a Patient:


Please be sure to Place the BED REQUEST (see Bed Request Section of this manual) order electronically as soon as you and a hospitalist or the accepting MD has agreed on admission. This should be done right at the same time as placing the BED ICON on the first net board.

NB: A delay here in placing this order will delay the admission process.

Be sure to check whether any *CoSigns* are needed before signing off your shift !!



- #2. Review the Orders that were placed per protocol:
- as a batch with all orders checked.
- individually by deselecting individual orders not to be cosigned.
- or deselect the entire list by unclicking the option found at the bottom left and check the orders off as they are reviewed.



Left click on Cosign signs all the orders and also eliminates that icon on the tracking board.

No clinical checking will be performed upon cosigning.



- Sign Out of the computer before leaving to safeguard access to the system.


You can open the patient record in 3 was:

1. Left clicking the patient's name to highlight in gray, then use the Open Patient Chart icon on the upper left (see below).




• **Double left click** on the patient's name, left click on to access the Order entry screen.


